1. Authorization

The Carrier named above authorizes 1Up Logistics LLC ("Dispatcher") to act as Carrier's limited administrative agent for dispatch-related tasks only. This authorization is limited to communicating with brokers/shippers/receivers, presenting load options, booking loads only with Carrier approval, transmitting paperwork, and assisting with status updates and invoicing support.

Carrier retains full control over load acceptance, rates, equipment, drivers, routing, and all transportation operations.

2. Limited Authority Scope

- Request and receive rate confirmations, load details, and broker instructions.
- Communicate dispatch updates (pickup, in transit, delivery, detention requests, etc.).
- Send/receive paperwork such as rate confirmations, PODs, and invoices as directed by Carrier.
- Negotiate rates and terms only when authorized by Carrier for each load or lane.
- Be added as a dispatch/load-board seat user under Carrier's account where applicable.

3. Restrictions

- Dispatcher is not a motor carrier and does not provide transportation.
- Dispatcher is not a freight broker and will not take possession or control of freight.
- Dispatcher may not sign contracts on behalf of Carrier unless separately and expressly authorized in writing.
- Dispatcher may not endorse checks, collect factoring payments, or access bank accounts.
- Dispatcher may not bind Carrier to any obligation beyond approved dispatch activities.

4. Effective Term

This authorization becomes effective on _____ and remains in effect until _____ or until revoked in writing by either party, subject to any notice requirements in the Dispatch Services Agreement. Either party may provide written notice of revocation. Carrier is responsible for notifying brokers/load boards/factoring companies when access should be removed.
